- This includes guests of your children
- We are required by law to know who is on the premises

**Reservations must be made by seasonals on behalf of guests.**

### DAY PASS:

ADULT.....\$4.00  
CHILDREN (under age 16) .....\$1.50  
Checkout Time .....10:00 pm  
Refund if visit is less than 30 minutes

### OVERNIGHT PASS:

If staying in seasonal trailer,

ADULT:.....\$6.00  
CHILDREN (under age 16) .....\$2.50

### CAMPING RATES:

\* Rates are based on 2 people per unit

Hookups ..... \$45.00/night  
No Hookups ..... \$40.00/night  
Additional Adult .....\$5.00  
Children age 4-15 .....\$2.50  
Pets .....\$2.00

\*Note: To rent campsite, you must be 21 or over.

Children or guests of seasonals under 21 are not allowed to stay overnight without a parent present.

## SWIMMING POOL & BEACH

FREE to seasonals and guests.

Pool Hours ..... 10 am – 8 pm  
Pool opens when weather permits through Labor Day weekend.

### **LIFEGUARD NOT ON DUTY**

Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.  
No dogs or boats allowed in beach area.  
No glass bottles or containers.  
No tubing, jet skiing or water skiing on lake.  
Trolling speed only on lake.

### PLAYGROUND

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.



## RULES

### **FAILURE TO OBEY RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION WITHOUT REFUND.**

1. ALL CAMPER AND GUESTS MUST REGISTER AND CHECK OUT AT THE MAIN OFFICE.
2. Window sticker **MUST** be displayed on windshield at all times.
3. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by minors is forbidden.
4. Campfires must **NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED.**
5. Mopeds, ATVs, etc. **ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
6. All vehicles must have licensed drivers, including golf carts.
7. **DOGS** must be leashed at all times and must not be left unattended. Dog litter should be disposed of in dumpsters. No dogs allowed in beach area.
8. **QUIET TIME** is from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am. 11:00 pm curfew for children.
9. Destroying the natural beauty of the campground is not permitted. Cutting live trees or defacing property in any way will result in a \$500 FINE.
10. Any site changes must be approved by Dick. Also, schedule Camperville work crew jobs in office.
