NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.

No dogs, canoes or boats allowed in beach area.

No glass bottles or containers.

No tubing, jet skiing or water skiing on lake.

Trolling speed only on Lake.



PLAYGROUND

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL

Camperville Garbage Only! NO outside dumping!

Large items cost to remove – please pay in office.

RULES

FAILURE TO OBEY RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION WITHOUT REFUND.

1. ALL CAMPERS AND GUESTS MUST REGISTER AND CHECK OUT AT THE MAIN OFFICE.
2. Window sticker **MUST** be displayed on windshield at all times.
3. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by minors is forbidden.
4. Campfires must **NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED**.
5. Mopeds, ATVs, etc. **ARE NOT ALLOWED**.
6. All vehicles must have licensed drivers, including golf carts. No off road driving. **SPEED LIMIT - 5 MPH.**
7. **DOGS** must be leashed at all times and must not be left unattended. Dog litter should be disposed of in dumpsters. No dogs allowed in beach area.
8. **QUIET TIME** is from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am. 11:00 pm curfew for children.
9. Destroying the natural beauty of the campground is not permitted. Cutting live trees or defacing property in any way will result in a \$500 FINE.
10. Any site changes must be pre-approved by Richard. Please schedule Camperville work crew jobs in office.
